



Authors' guidelines

Please notice: The paper must not be published previously in another journal!

The article may extend over approx. 6 to 10 printed pages in the journal.

Required data are:

Text

- Please supply the text as a Word processing file (doc / docx)
- Length approx. 10000 to 16000 characters (without blanks)
- Short, concise title, not more than 100 characters (without blanks)
- Information on the author and if applicable the co-authors: **Full names with academic titles**, Company/university (with city/country) as well as professional occupation/position
- Summary consisting of a maximum of 300 characters (without blanks)
- Sections numbered consecutively from 1 to n (1 / 1.1 / 1.1.1; beginning with the section "1 Introduction"

Figures/Tables

- Please include a high-resolution leading image with figure caption strikingly highlighting the content of your contribution – size min. 2 MB at a picture size of 10 x 15 cm with 300 dpi
- Please number/caption figures consecutively beginning with Fig. 1
- Figure references: e.g., "**Figure 1** shows ..." or as a reference in brackets "(**Fig. 1**)"
- Please number/caption tables consecutively beginning with Tab. 1
- References to tables: e.g., "**Table 1** shows ..." or as a reference in brackets "(**Tab. 1**)"
- Graphic data files e.g. as "tiff", "eps" or "jpg", resolution with format 10 x 15 cm = 300 dpi
- All figure and table captions should be placed at the end of the text with consecutive numbering as a list
- The most advantageous number of figures is 1 to 2 per printed page of the journal
- Please **do not embed** digital figures in the text or in the Word document!

Literature

- The literature should be placed at the end of the text
- The bibliography references must be numbered consecutively in square brackets [1] to [n]
- The bibliography index (should contain not too many and only relevant bibliography quotes)

Example:

[2] Smith, J.: Cement Clinker, in: Brand, F. (Publisher): Cement Chemistry, Paul & Brock, Berlin, 2020, pp. 39-56

Translation/File transfer

The translation into English can be carried out by the publisher. The quality of the translation can be greatly improved, if you are able to include either German or English language documentation of the project (leaflets, other publications etc.).
